

BLOCK SPLITTER/TILE CUTTER

Intended use

The block splitter/tile cutter is suitable for accurate splitting of paving blocks, concrete tiles or curb stones, with a cutting height of 1 cm to 12 cm maximum. The maximum cut width is 33 cm. The splitter is not suitable for paving stones.



Caution!

Improper handling can injure the user or damage the device. Read the safety instructions first!

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS











- Observe the warnings and indications on the splitter. It is prohibited to remove these caution indicators.
- · Move the splitter by using the transport arm and wheels. Caution! The splitter weighs 41 kg. If necessary, the splitter should be lifted by at least two persons.
- · Always place the splitter on a flat surface and ensure that the splitter is positioned stable.
- Keep children and pets out of reach of the machine.
- · Never leave the splitter unattended.

1. OPERATING FUNCTIONS



- Transport arm Transport wheels Splitter handle
- Height setting Blade D E F Splitter table

2. OPERATING



- 1. Place the splitter on a flat, stable surface.
- 2. Move the splitter handle upwards.
- 3. Use the two levers to adjust the blade to the correct height. Caution! Block or tile fits easily between knife and cutting table (approx. 5 mm clearance between knife and stone).

Caution! Set the left and right height settings at the same height.

- 4. Place the block or tile on the splitter table
 - At right angles to the splitter blade to cut the block or tile straight;
 - or at an angle if needed to split across.
- 5. Push the splitter handle down to cut block or tile.

Note! During work, keep the splitter table and direct surroundings of the splitter clean and uncluttered.

3. AFTER USE

- 1. Clear the work area
- 2. Clean the splitter with a brush.
